YOUR IMPORTANT DOCUMENT

Your puppy's original, breeder-signed CKC Puppy Registration Application contains the unique information needed to register your puppy in your name.

Keep this brochure with your puppy records.

What CKC Registration Means

Continental Kennel Club registration creates an official registry record for your dog and assigns a unique CKC registration number after the application is approved.

Your registration can help you:

- Document your dog's registered identity and ownership.
- Maintain registry information connected to the breeder-recorded litter.
- Order eligible CKC certificates, pedigrees, and other services.
- Access CKC member resources and account features.

IMPORTANT DISTINCTION

Registration records information submitted to the registry. It is not a veterinary examination, health guarantee, temperament guarantee, or proof that a dog should be bred.

Which CKC?

This brochure refers to Continental Kennel Club in the United States (ckcusa.com), not the Canadian Kennel Club.

Before You Begin

Have these items ready:

- The complete original CKC Puppy Registration Application supplied by Mason Meadow.
- The breeder's signature already completed on the application.
- Your legal name and a valid, clearly written physical address.
- Your preferred registered name for the puppy.
- Payment for the CKC registration package or services you select.

DO NOT LOSE THE APPLICATION

Each litter-issued puppy application has unique registration information. Store the original safely and photograph both sides for your personal records.

No rush—but register early

CKC states that Puppy Registration Applications do not expire and that it does not charge a late fee. Registering soon helps place the official record in your name and gives you earlier access to member benefits.

How to Register

1 Create or sign in to MyCKC

Go to ckcusa.com and open the Puppy Registration page. Sign in or create a MyCKC account.

2 Choose Puppy Registration

Use the “Puppy Registration Form” in your account—not the general Dog Registration Form when you already have a breeder-issued puppy application.

3 Enter the application details

Carefully copy the unique puppy application number and requested information. Complete all owner and puppy fields.

4 Select services and submit

Review spelling, choose the registration package or optional products you want, pay the applicable fees, and submit.

5 Save your confirmation

Keep the original application, submission confirmation, and final certificate together with your puppy’s records.

CKC also accepts completed applications by mail, fax, or email according to its current instructions. Online steps and package choices may change; follow the current CKC website.

Avoid Common Mistakes

- Do not use a nickname if you want a different formal registered name. Check spelling before submitting.
- Do not discard the original application after registering.
- Do not alter breeder, litter, sire, dam, sex, color, or date-of-birth information. Contact Mason Meadow if something appears incorrect.
- Do not submit an unsigned application; CKC requires both breeder and registrant signatures.
- Do not assume the microchip is automatically registered with a recovery database. Complete microchip enrollment separately.
- Do not confuse CKC registration with local dog licensing. Follow your city or county requirements as well.

IF PAPERWORK IS MISSING

Contact Mason Meadow first. CKC says reissued puppy applications must be requested through the breeder and cannot be sent directly to the new puppy owner.

Already registered to another owner?

A previously registered dog uses CKC’s Transfer of Ownership process rather than a new puppy registration. The original certificate and completed transfer information may be required.

After Registration

- Review the certificate immediately for spelling and factual errors.
- Keep the certificate, puppy application, purchase contract, microchip record, and veterinary records in a safe place.
- Update CKC if your mailing address changes.
- Use the ownership-transfer section and current CKC instructions if the dog is later transferred.
- Ask CKC directly about pedigrees, duplicate documents, co-ownership, or account questions.
